PHILOSOPHY OF GECCS

GECCS is an independent, educational ministry which is thoroughly Biblical in its philosophy of education, as well as, a ministry to the local church providing curriculum, consultation, and direction for its educational goal accomplishments.

GECCS abides by the evangelical teachings and focus on “Equipping the World through the Word”.

We also focus on three major learning streams:

1. The Bible in its entirety, how to understand it better, how to handle more wisely the Word of God and how to apply the Word of God in our daily lives. 1 Tim. 4:6-16, 6:35; UTim. 2:/15
2. The Spiritual Christian Growth of the student, to strive toward the measure of stature of the fullness of Christ to reach toward maturity in leadership and in servant hood. Eph 4:13-16
3. The Preparation for Ministry to enable each person to discover his or her calling in God to serve Jesus Christ through the five-fold ministry. Our teaching methodology is pastoral mentoring, distant learning, independent study, external studies, and accelerated track programs.

We affirm the divine inspiration, truthfulness, and authority of both Old and New testament Scriptures, in their entirety, as the only written Word of God, without error in all that it affirms, and the only infallible rule of life, faith, and practice. We also affirm the power of God’s Word to accomplish His purpose of salvation. The message of the Bible is addressed to all mankind for God’s revelation in Christ and in Scripture is unchangeable. Through it, the Holy Spirit still speaks today. He illuminates the minds of God’s people in every culture to preserve its truth freshly through their own eyes.

GECCS recognizes the authority and autonomy of the local church and therefore, will not interfere with the local church’s life, its discipline, or its

doctrinal emphasis. All student learners must complete an application/ portfolio resume and be evaluated for the desired Degree program and Tuition. Once accepted students shall receive on-line distance learning syllabus.

ACADEMIC STATEMENT

The academic degree programs are individually designed to meet the skills required to be effective in their prospective field of service and religious field of employment. Moreover, it is the discretion of any secular place of employment whether or not students may advance in the secular field of employment.

Credit hours: The average course is 3 credit hours. However, some courses may range from 3 to 14 hours per course possibly more than 15 hours. The hourly schedule is flexible.

Students in the non-degree certificate program do not have to possess a GED or Diploma.

Students in the degree program must possess a High School Diploma or GED or equivalent. The degree program has a yearly enrollment policy. Students may be evaluated and accepted into a degree program certificate program during anytime of the year.

Classes may be arranged at the discretion of the director. Director may arrange monitoring programs.

The 10 courses certificate program should last at least 10 months based on the progress of the student. May be less. However, 10 months is a good range for the certificate program.

COURSE OF STUDY

OVERVIEW

The course work is designed as an overview. The average student should be able to complete the first year in 9 months. The above average Student can complete the course in less time and move into the next level.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS (One Year)

1. Read Foxes Book of Martyrs. Do a book report (2pages). www.sacred-texts.com/chr/martyrs
2. Students are encouraged to pray at least 1 hour a day. (Prayer can be alone or corporate).
3. Students are encouraged to fast 1 day per week.
4. Students are to read the bible through. (Bible in numerous languages). www.bible.com/bibleread.html
5. Students are to keep a journal. In this journal they should detail their accomplishment, prayer, fasting, thoughts, revelations, etc.
6. Read 3 books on religion, theology, Christian living or related subjects - 2 from the **Recommended Reading List** and 1 of the student's choice - and do a book report on each (2pages). www.geocities.com/icof2003/reading.htm
7. Students will read Dr Bernie Wade's book, *Baptism According to Matthew 28:19*, and do a report on the same.
8. Student/learner will complete a practicum and colloque.

ASSOCIATE DEGREE (Year 2)

60 CREDIT HOURS

1. Students are encouraged to fast 1 day per week.
2. Students are encouraged to pray at least 1 hour a day.
3. Students are to read the bible through.
4. Students are to keep a journal. In this journal they should detail their accomplishment, prayer, fasting, thoughts and revelations.
5. Read 4books over the course of the year and do a book report on each (2 pages). 3books from the **Recommended Reading List** and 1of the student's choice.
6. 60 Semester hours of study or its equivalent.

COURSE REQUIRMENTS (Three Year)

1. Students are encouraged to pray at least 1 hour a day
2. Students are encouraged to fast 1 day per week.
3. Students are to read the bible through.
4. Students are to keep a journal.
5. Read 4 books over the course of the year and do a book report on each (2pages). 2 from the **Recommended Reading List** and 2 of the student's choice.
6. Student/learner will complete a practicum and colloquy.

**BACHELORS DEGREE (FOUR YEAR)
120 CREDIT HOURS**

1. Students are encouraged to pray at least 1 hour a day.
2. Students are encouraged to fast 1 day per week.
3. Students are to read the bible through.
4. Students are to keep a journal. In this journal they should detail their accomplishments, prayer, fasting, thoughts, revelations, etc.
5. Read 4 books over the course of the year and do a book reports on each (2 pages). 1 from the **Recommended Reading List** and 3 of the student's choice.
6. 120 hours of study or its equivalent
7. Student/learner will complete a practicum and colloquy.

MASTERS PROGRAM

1. Students are encouraged to pray at least 1 hour a day.
2. Students are encouraged to fast 1 day per week.
3. Students are to read the bible through.
4. Students are to keep a journal. In this journal they should detail their accomplishments, prayer, fasting, thoughts, revelations, etc.
5. Read 4 books over the course of the year and do a book report on each (2 pages). 2 of the student's choice and 2 from the **Recommended Reading List**.
6. Masters Thesis - 60 pages in the student's field of study.
7. Student/learner will complete a practicum and colloquy.

DOCTORAL COURSE REQUIREMENTS

1. Students are encouraged to pray at least 1 hour a day.
2. Students are encouraged to fast 1 day per week.
3. Students are to read the bible through.
4. Students are to keep a journal.
5. Write a Doctoral Thesis - 150 pages.
6. Student/learner will complete a practicum and colloquy.

PHD

1. Active participate in field practicum with approved mentor, preaching, teaching, missionary effort, etc.
2. (2) Thesis- 200 pages.

Honorary Degrees

Qualified Ministers with experience can apply for an Honorary degree. Submit an application and considerable donation. Honorary degrees are given to rare people for major achievements in the field of the degree. GECCS College only offers a total of 4 honorary doctorates worldwide annually.

Christian Life Experience Program (CLEP)

Ministers or lay members with appropriate church experience (i.e. pastor, teacher, evangelist, missionary, choir director, music minister, etc) can receive credit toward a degree. Applicants need to submit an application. Minimum of 30 hours must be completed through GECCS on any level.
